Listed by Intertek Testing Services, the Ductmate doors are included in FyreWrap Design Listings and are approved for the FyreWrap Elite™ 1.5 two layer ASTM E-2336 Grease Duct (GD) System and single layer systems qualified for Hazardous Ducts. The doors are also specifically referenced in the new Unifrax ICCES Evaluation Service Report number ESR-2224.

These new approvals offer contractors and local authorities the flexibility to meet job site conditions and the documentation required to verify compliance with local regulations. This will eliminate any doubt as to whether Ductmate brand doors have been evaluated specifically with the FyreWrap brand duct wrap.

The doors are available with optional extended threaded rods, cover plate and associated hardware. This eliminates the need for any special tools, on-site welding or use of other trades to fabricate or attach door components.
